Children in the Courts is an annual legal conference that brings together multidisciplinary advocates and experts in the fields of child welfare and family law. Sponsored by the Administrative Office of the Courts - Court Improvement Program, the conference offers continuing education and training for those providing representation to children and families in Arkansas's courts.

We are seeking knowledgeable and dynamic speakers for the 2019 Children in the Courts Conference. The conference theme is "Connecting the Dots" and will be focused on building connections between advocates, providers, resources and Arkansas's at-risk children and their families.
