## **ORDER**

Circuit Judge Stacey A. Zimmerman, of the 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for "other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed." Judge Zimmerman will be presiding over a hearing in a separate matter in Washington County, which will conflict with the regularly scheduled Juvenile docket in Madison County on the same day.
