## ORDER


Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. David Graham, of the 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, is hereby assigned to the Columbia County and Ouachita County District Courts, to sit on the following dates:


January 11, 2024 in Magnolia

The assignment of Judge Graham to the Columbia County and Ouachita County District Courts entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 1<sup>st</sup> Division, shall remain in Judge Graham to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
