
## ORDER

Circuit Judge Troy Braswell has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge Charles Yeargan, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 2<sup>nd</sup> Division, to sit on the following date:

April 3, 2024

On that date, Judge Yeargan will preside over the juvenile docket scheduled in Faulkner County and Judge Braswell will preside over the criminal trial that is scheduled within the same circuit.
