Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Arkansas County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Jason Carter, State District Court Judge, 22nd Judicial District Court, Lee County and Phillips County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Arkansas County District Court, DeWitt Department, to hear the following case:

City of DeWitt v. Melanie Adams - CR-22-2241

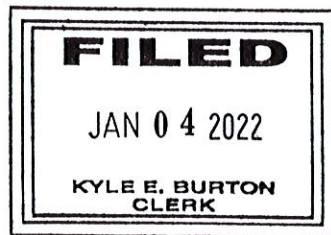
The assignment of Judge Carter to the Arkansas County District Court, DeWitt Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date to the Arkansas County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Carter.

The assignment of Judge Carter to the Arkansas County District Court, DeWitt Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Lee County and Phillips County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Carter to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
