ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Cross County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Fred Thorne, 21st Judicial District Court, Crittenden County District Court, is hereby assigned to the Cross County District Court, to hear the following case:

City of Wynne v. James L. Summage – CR24-255

The assignment of Judge Thorne to the Cross County District Court, Wynne Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Cross County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said cause, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Thorne.

The assignment of Judge Thorne to the Cross County District Court, Wynne Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Crittenden County District Court, shall remain in Judge Thorne to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
