## ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Independence County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Henry Boyce, State District Court Judge, 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Jackson County and Woodruff County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Independence County District Court, Batesville Department, to hear the following case:

*Freddie & Margaret Freeman v. Aaron Williams A & K Construction* – BACV-21-225

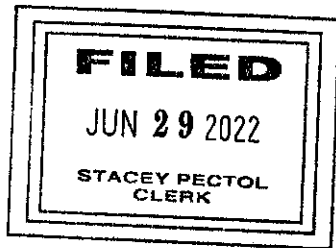
The assignment of Judge Boyce to the Independence County District Court, Batesville Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on July 22, 2022, due to the Independence County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Boyce.

The assignment of Judge Boyce to the Independence County District Court, Batesville Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Jackson County and Woodruff County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Boyce to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
