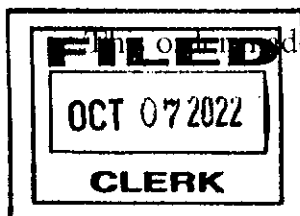

ORDER


Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. Charles Clawson, of the 20th Judicial Circuit, is hereby assigned to the Faulkner County District Court, Mayflower Department, Division 2, to sit on the following date:

October 13, 2022 (morning only)

The assignment of Judge Clawson to the Faulkner County District Court, Mayflower Department, Division 2, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the 20th Judicial Circuit, 3rd Division, shall remain in Judge Clawson to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
