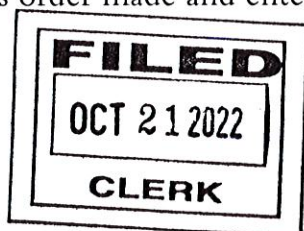
ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Cindy Thyer is covering a criminal trial scheduled in Poinsett County, which will conflict with her regularly scheduled Domestic Relations and Probate docket in Crittenden County. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge Barbara Halsey, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 2nd Judicial Circuit, 4th Division, to sit on the following date:

October 26, 2022

On that date, Judge Halsey will assume Judge Thyer’s regularly scheduled Domestic Relations and Probate docket in Crittenden County, while Judge Thyer presides over a criminal trial in Poinsett County in the same circuit.
