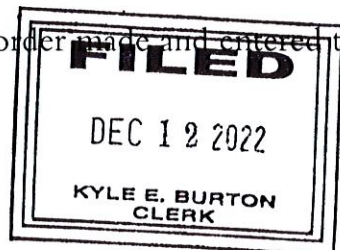
ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge Randy Hill, State District Court Judge, 40th Judicial District Court, Clark County District Court, is hereby assigned to the 9th East Judicial Circuit, to sit on an “as-needed” basis on the following dates:

December 19 through December 23, 2022

The assignment of Judge Hill to the 9th East Judicial Circuit entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Clark County District Court, shall remain in Judge Hill to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
