## **Proposed Amendment Language**

For calendar year 2025, these judges will hear the following type cases in Pulaski County:

- 1. Judges Byrd-Manning and Shanice Johnson will share in the juvenile caseload.
- 2. Judges Gill, Leon Johnson, Honorable, Martin, and Whatley will share in the criminal caseload.
- 3. Judges Compton, Connors, Fox, James, and Shawn Johnson will share in the civil caseload.
- 4. Judges Honorable, Amy Johnson, Reif, Tucker, the judge in 4<sup>th</sup> Division, and the new circuit court judge elected in 17<sup>th</sup> Division will share in the domestic relations and probate caseload.
- 5. The 4<sup>th</sup> Division Judge will preside over Civil Commitment Mental Health Court. The remaining judges in the 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit will serve as back-up in emergency situations.
- 6. Judges Connors and Shawn Johnson will keep any Domestic Relations/Probate cases which are open on their dockets on December 31, 2024 or which reopen thereafter.
