ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2011), (the "Procedures"), Attorney Justin Byrum Hurst, submitted his Petition for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law. The Petition was considered by Panel A of the Committee on Professional Conduct.

- Petitioner was suspended for two (2) months by Order of the Committee on January
 11, 2023. Petitioner has completed his suspension and complied with Sections 21 of the

 Procedures.
- 3. By majority vote, Panel A has voted to reinstate Justin Byrum Hurst to the active practice of law in Arkansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Petitioner's Petition for Reinstatement be granted and said reinstatement shall become effective upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
