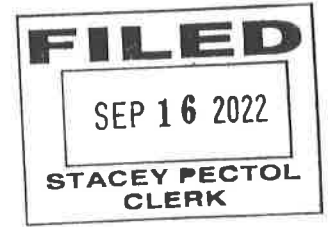

ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

Respondent, Quentin Ellery May, Arkansas Bar No. 2006034, an attorney practicing law primarily in Little Rock, Arkansas, is placed on Interim Suspension.

A Panel of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, having voted in this case to initiate disbarment proceedings against the Respondent, pursuant to the authority of Section 16(A)(1), Procedures of the Arkansas Supreme Court Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (the "Procedures") (Rev. 2011), finds that an interim suspension of Respondent's privilege to practice law under the authority of his Arkansas law license be imposed pursuant to Sections 17.E(3)(a).

It is therefore ORDERED that the Arkansas law license of Respondent, Quentin Ellery May, be, and he hereby is, SUSPENDED immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
