ORDER OF SUSPENSION ON RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE ACTION

Panel B of the Committee on Professional Conduct has considered the Complaint & Notice of Reciprocal Discipline Action filed against Respondent Susan Madeline Weinberg, AR Bar #77191, of Boca Raton, Florida, and finds:

- 1. By letter dated November 17, 2011, Ms. Weinberg self-reported to the Committee that she had been disciplined in the State of Florida. The Order of Discipline of the Florida State Bar issued on September 20, 2011, effective October 21, 2011, sanctioning Respondent Attorney with a suspension of ninety one (91) days.
- The Complaint and Notice of Reciprocal Discipline before the Committee on Professional Conduct was filed December 16, 2011.
 - 3 The Complaint was served on Ms. Weinberg on or about December 29, 2011.
- 4. On January 10, 2012, the Office of Professional Responsibility received a letter from Ms. Weinberg agreeing to the sanction of a 91 day suspension.
- 5. Panel B finds that the requirements in Section 14 of the Arkansas Procedures for imposing a reciprocal sanction to that imposed by Florida are met with regard to notice and other compliance.
- 6. An "active" suspension of Ms. Weinberg's Arkansas law license for ninety-one (91) days shall be imposed, to commence with the date this order becomes final and is filed with the

Clerk of the Supreme Court of Arkansas.

7. Upon the commencement of her Arkansas suspension, Ms. Weinberg shall comply with the requirements of Sections 21 and 22 of the Arkansas Procedures regarding "former," or suspended, attorneys.

IT IS ORDERED by Panel A that the Arkansas law license of Respondent Susan Madeline Weinberg, AR Bar #77191, be, and it hereby is, suspended for a period of ninety-one (91) days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Arkansas, and that after serving her suspension, Ms. Weinberg may petition the Committee for reinstatement to good standing as provided in Section 23 of the Arkansas Procedures.
