ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT TO PRACTICE OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2002), (the "Procedures"), Attorney Charles Gregory Alagood, submitted his Petition for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law. The Petition was considered by Panel A of the Committee on Professional Conduct.

2. Petitioner was suspended from the practice of law in Arkansas by Order of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, effective September 16, 2002 for a period of three (3) years. Petitioner did not practice law nor petition for reinstatement until September 23, 2005.

3. By majority vote, Panel A has voted to reinstate Charles Gregory Alagood to the active practice of law in Arkansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Petitioner's Petition for Reinstatement be granted and said reinstatement shall become effective upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
